12th Sunday in Ordinary Time

One's name is linked inseparably to one's identity and to one's actions. One's name could even dictate one's mission in life.

Take the case of Jean Valjean, the protagonist in Victor Hugo's *Les Misérables*. Imprisoned for 19 years, Valjean is finally out on parole, which he breaks forthwith. He goes to a faraway place, and there succeeds in building a new life under a different name. Eventually, he becomes the mayor of a town.

But Javert, a police officer, continues to search for Valjean whose identity he has reduced to the prison number 24601. One day, the zealous cop arrests an innocent man whom he has mistaken for the elusive prisoner. In a haunting monologue, Valjean asks himself, "Who am I?" He is Madeleine, the town mayor, a businessman on

whom many depend for their livelihood, but he is also Jean Valjean, who once stole a loaf of bread for his sister's starving children. For this act, he was imprisoned and his identity reduced to a prison number. Now Valjean is determined to be true to himself and saves another man from such a dire fate.

"You are the Messiah"

In today's Gospel, Jesus asks his disciples: "Who do people say that I am?" They tell him that some people say he is John the Baptist. Others presume that he is Elijah. Still, others say that he is one of the prophets.

None of these answers is accurate, and so he asks them: "But who do you say that I am?" It is Peter who answers for the Twelve, confessing, "You are the Messiah."



One day Jesus put this question to his disciples: "But you, who do you say I am?"
